## HOUSING

All Hostel YOUTH! Company Members will be housed in the Residence Hall - Miller Hall. Most of the housing is dormitory-style suites with two bedrooms and one bathroom with a stand-up shower. The residence halls are just downhill from the Frank Center and across the street from the Center for Contemporary Arts and are a 5-10 minute walk to all Theater Spaces, Dining Hall and downtown Shepherdstown.

In the suites, each Bedroom has two twin beds, 1 bureau, 2 wardrobes, 2 desks, 2 chairs and an air conditioning unit.

You will be issued keys to your suite when you arrive. A lost key to a suite requires changing all the locks in the suite and cutting new keys which will cost \$250.

## PARKING

Parking is available in the F and J lots as noted on the enclosed map. Once you have checked-in at the office an AMBASSADOR of the Hostel YOUTH! will show you to your room and help you settle in.

## CLEANING & MAINTENANCE

The Hostel YOUTH! are responsible for the cleanliness of their suite. Cleaning supplies will be made available. If you spill something on the carpet of your room please notify Company Management immediately. Please inform Company Management of any issues with your housing.

There are no available phone lines in the residence halls. If you do not have a cell phone and need access to local calling, phones are available in the offices of CATF.

## DRESS

It may be chilly in the mornings and evenings, be prepared with a sweatshirt or spring jacket. The Eastern Panhandle can become rather warm and muggy too, so make sure you have cool, comfortable summer clothing with you. The theaters are all air conditioned and often a light jacket or sweater is needed.

Shepherdstown is a very old, small, quiet town with the highest number of art studios and PhDs of any city in the country per capita. The town is very enchanting and historical. There are some great restaurants and local shops. The downtown area is within walking distance.

Shepherdstown is a college town and the local authorities are aware of the dates and times of our events. Be sure to follow Speed Limits (usually 15 or 25 around town) and come to a complete and total stop at every stop sign.

Parking meters in town and on campus are also monitored very closely. Be sure to put money in and remember that 45 minutes means 45 minutes.

Once you get on campus, come to the Center for Contemporary Arts at 92 West Campus Drive, Breezeway to check in with the CATF Hostel Youth Residents. Parking is open to everyone in Lots F and J during the summer and there is plenty of Handicapped Parking.
